

CPR training

For nursing and non-clinical staff working within primary care practice

Nurses and non-clinical staff working within primary care practice are invited to register for one of two free Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training sessions held in Atherton.

Background

The Australian General Practice Accreditation Limited (AGPAL) Standards 5th Edition: Compliance Data identified that Standard 8 Criterion C8.1 Education and training of non-clinical staff was not being met in general practice. It is also noted that general practices are required to have completed basic life support training to maintain their accreditation.

To support general practice in maintaining a high standard of care, Northern Queensland Primary Health Network (NQPHN) is investing in the provision of free CPR training across the North Queensland catchment.

Program

The CPR training sessions comprising of the skills and knowledge required to perform CPR in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines. This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide CPR in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.
